All are safe and it is important to note that we are not in the midst of an active event.

At approximately 8:45 a.m. today, Nashua High School North was secured into lockdown. This lockdown was initiated as a precaution after school officials were notified of a single bullet found in one of the bathrooms. Nashua Police are at the school now and are investigating.

There were no threats or messages connected to the ammunition, and there is no known threat at this time. Students at Nashua North will be dismissed early, starting now at 11:30 a.m.

We understand and respect that events like this can cause concern and many questions. We want to assure you that our students remain safe and supported. We appreciate the level of trust that is required in sending your children into our care and we want you to know that as educators and parents ourselves, we take that responsibility very seriously.
