

SITE SELECTION

The Board of Education, in accordance with the powers vested through state statutes, has the authority to select school sites. To assist with this process, the Support Services Committee of the Board shall have the responsibility to review sites and to make a recommendation to the Board.

In assessing school sites, the Board and its Support Services Committee will review demographic data, standards, and other relevant criteria and attempt to make decisions based on both short-term and long-range needs. Information may be solicited from a variety of persons and sources including, but not limited to, the Superintendent of Schools and the administrative staff, architects and engineers, consultants, and personnel from the City Planning Department. School Site Standards outlined by the New Hampshire Department of Education will also be considered during the site selection process.
