

PROHIBITION ON SALE OF MINIMAL NUTRITIVE VALUE FOOD

In accordance with regulations issued by the U. S. Department of Agriculture, the sale of certain foods, determined to be of minimal nutritive value to children, on the school premises from the start of the day until after the last lunch period are prohibited. Foods which have been identified in this category of sales restriction are 1) soda water, 2) water ices, 3) chewing gum, and 4) certain candies including hard candies, jellies and gums, marshmallow candies, and fondants.
