

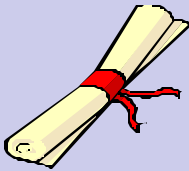
Registration Information

NHS North—Students should pick up a registration form from their counselor or in the main office. Completed forms should be returned to your counselor by the end of the school day on Friday, March 11

NHS South—Students should pick up a registration form from their counselor or in the main office. Completed forms should be returned to your counselor by the end of the school day on Friday, March 11

All Students—Regarding payment...

- You should bring full payment of \$150 with you.
- If you cannot afford to pay the full \$150 at this time and would like to go on a payment plan, please bring a \$20 registration with you.
- If you are on free lunch, the cost is \$10. if you are on reduced lunch, the cost is \$40.
- Payments are non-refundable. Limited scholarships are available.

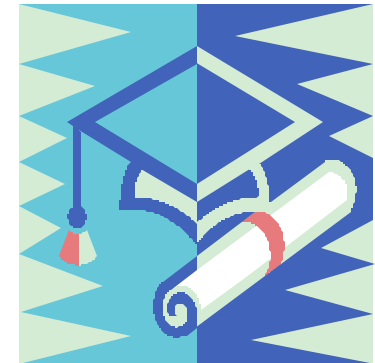

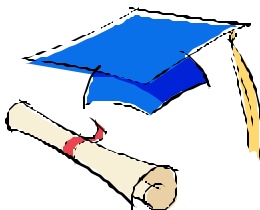
Credit Recovery Programs



If you have failed a course at Nashua High School North or Nashua High School South, there are several ways you can make up the course and recover the credit you have lost.

Summer School is available to all students. Information about summer school will be available in May. The program will take place in July.

Night School is available to seniors upon the recommendation of your guidance counselor and requires the approval of the Principal of NHS North, R. Patrick Corbin ; the Principal of NHS South, Timothy Kelley or the Director of the Nashua Adult Community School, Margaret Reynolds. A limited number of credits can be earned in this way. An interview with either Mr. Corbin, Mr. Kelley or Miss Reynolds is also required prior to your acceptance into this program.



After-School Credit Recovery

Credit Recovery is now available to help students who failed first semester courses make-up that credit right away. This program is open to all students in grades 9-12 who have passed one of the two quarters under block scheduling or who earned 1/2 credit prior to the 03-04 school year under a 7-period schedule. Each course has a fee and has a strict attendance requirement

- Each course will meet for 45 hours (3 hours a week until the end of the school year).
- If you miss more than 3 classes, a failing grade will be issued. Each tardy to class of more than 10 minutes counts as 1/2 an absence. There are no "excused" or "unexcused" absences. If you are not in class, you are absent. It is that simple.
- Each course will cost \$150. Payment plans and limited scholarship funds are available.

Benefits

- You will be immediately able to re-take course while the information is still fresh in your mind.
- You will be able to "catch up" quickly to your graduating class.
- You will not need to miss part of your summer break to take these classes so you will still be able to go on vacation or to work.



- You will still be able to use your evenings to do homework or to work at a part-time job.
- You will be able to take classes on-site and will not need to return to school in the evening or over the summer to earn credits.
