Berne, Jennifer. Manfish: The Story of Jacques Cousteau

An illustrated biography of Jacques Cousteau, discussing how his youthful fascination with filming and underwater exploration translated into his life's work, and telling of his later devotion to saving the ocean environment.

Blackall, Sophie. Hello Lighthouse

This story Explores the life of one lighthouse as it beams its message out to sea through shifting seasons, changeable weather, and the tenure of its final keeper.

Brett, Jan. The Mermaid

Set in the ocean off Japan, this retelling of *Goldilocks and the Three Bears* stars Kiniro, a mermaid, who finds a baby octopus's breakfast, chair, and bed just right.

Clanton, Ben. Narwhal: Unicorn of the Sea

Narwhal is a happy-go-lucky narwhal. Jelly is a no-nonsense jellyfish. The two might not have a lot in common, but they do ... love waffles, parties and adventures. Join Narwhal and Jelly as they discover the whole wide ocean together.

Chin, Jason. Coral Reefs

A girl pulls an extraordinary book about coral reefs from the library shelf, and as she turns the pages, finds herself immersed in the coral cities of the sea.

Cole, Joanna. The Magic School Bus on the Ocean Floor

On a special field trip aboard the magic school bus, Ms. Frizzle's class learns about the ocean and the different creatures that live there.

Cornwall, Gaia. Jabari Jumps

On a trip to the city pool, Jabari finds the courage to jump off the diving board with encouragement from his dad.

Dean, Thomas. Pete the Cat at the Beach

Pete the cat goes to the beach with his mom and brother.

Ferry, Beth. Swashby and the Sea

No-nonsense Captain Swashby is used to the sea meeting all of his needs and when, after his retirement, new neighbors disturb his solitary life, the sea helps in just the right way.

Herriges, Anne. Sea Stars

Learn all about sea stars in this informative nonfiction title. Ask a librarian to help you find more nonfiction titles about sea creatures.

Díaz, Junot. Islandborn

Lola was just a baby when her family left the Island, so when she has to draw it for a school assignment, she asks her family, friends, and neighbors about their memories of her homeland . . . and in the process, comes up with a new way of understanding her own heritage.

Kheiriyeh, Rashin. Saffron Ice Cream

Rashin is an Iranian immigrant girl living in New York, excited by her first trip to Coney Island, and fascinated by the differences in the beach customs between her native Iran and her new home--but she misses the saffron flavored ice cream that she used to eat.

LaRocca, Lajani. Where Three Oceans Meet

Sejal, Mommy, and Pati travel together to the southern tip of India. Along the way, they share meals, visit markets, and catch up with old friends. Check this title out at the Nashua Public Library Story Walk in the Children's Room.

Lies, Brian. Bats at the Beach

On a night when the moon can grow no fatter, bats pack their moon-tan lotion and baskets of treats and fly off for some fun on the beach.
