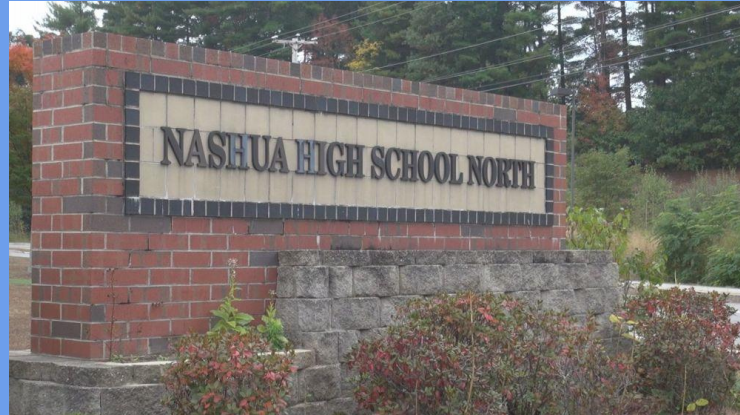


# Nashua High School North Class of 2023 Graduation



# Graduation Rehearsal/Cap and Gown Pickup:

**Date:** June 6, 2023

**Where:** Nashua North Athletic Wing (Large and Medium Gym)

**Time:** 10:00am

## **Rehearsal:**

- Graduates will arrive at Nashua North by 10:00am and proceed to the Athletic Wing
- Students will line up in the medium gym in their correct line and spot for procession
  - Lists will be shared and posted outside of the gymnasium
- Rehearsal will begin and some senior awards will be handed out
- Students will have their names read by assistant principals to ensure they are correct

## **Cap and Gown Pickup:**

- All fees must be paid and outstanding uniforms, books, etc. must be returned prior to receiving cap and gown
- After students have their names called, they will go back to the medium gym to pick up their cap and gown

# Graduation Ceremony Logistics:

**Date:** June 12, 2023 (Rain Date: June 14, 2023)

**Ceremony:** Begins at 7:00 PM

## **Arrival:**

- Students must arrive 1 hour before the ceremony - 6:00 PM
- Gates will open 1 hour prior to the start of the ceremony - 6:00 PM

## **Seating:**

- Seating is limited and each graduate will be allowed 6 guests
- There will not be tickets issued and we ask that families respect the seating limits

## **Parking:**

- Parking is available in the YMCA parking lot, 505 West Hollis Street, and at Nashua South
- A shuttle bus will be available to transport guests to and from South
- There will be no parking in the lot to the left of Stellos - that area is reserved for the graduates to line up
- Also, please do not park in the Conway Arena lot

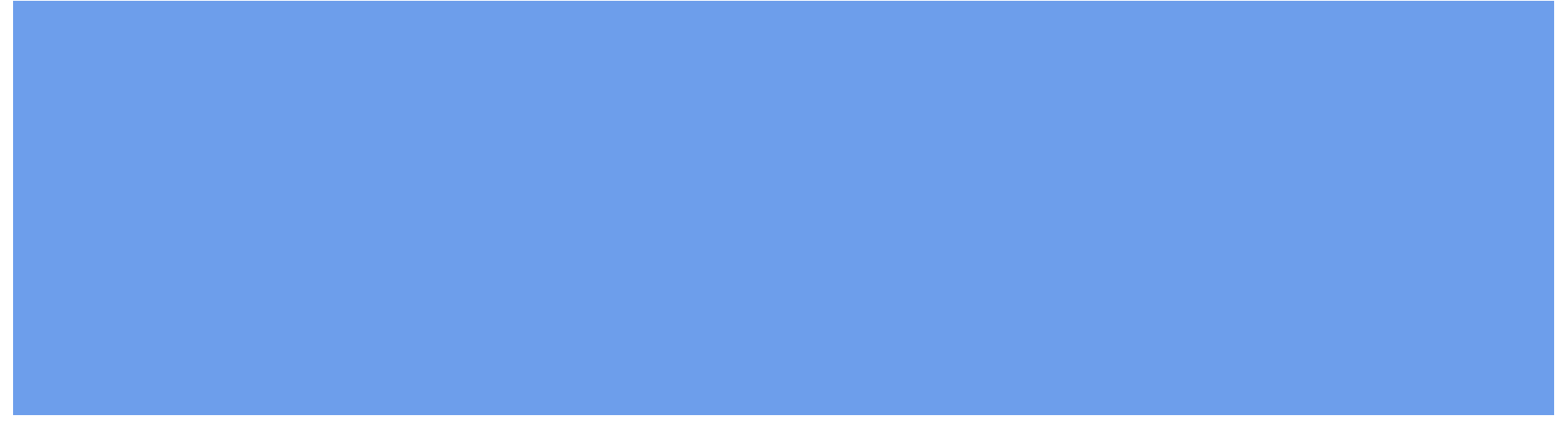
# Student Expectations

- Arrive 1 hour prior to the start of your graduation start time
  - Come in your Cap and Gown
  - Must exit the premises immediately after the ceremony, no congregating in the parking lot/facility
  - Students may not bring in water bottles, purses, food, etc.
  - Only authorized cords can be worn
  - Caps may be decorated, however, they must be appropriate and cannot extend more than two inches above the cap

# Student Seating/Lineup

- Students will be lined up in alphabetical order in the parking lot prior to the ceremony
- Students will receive their assigned seat at graduation rehearsal and should share that information with their invited guests
- Students must be wearing their cap and gowns
- Tassels should be on the right side
- Students will proceed into the stadium through the locker rooms and onto the field.

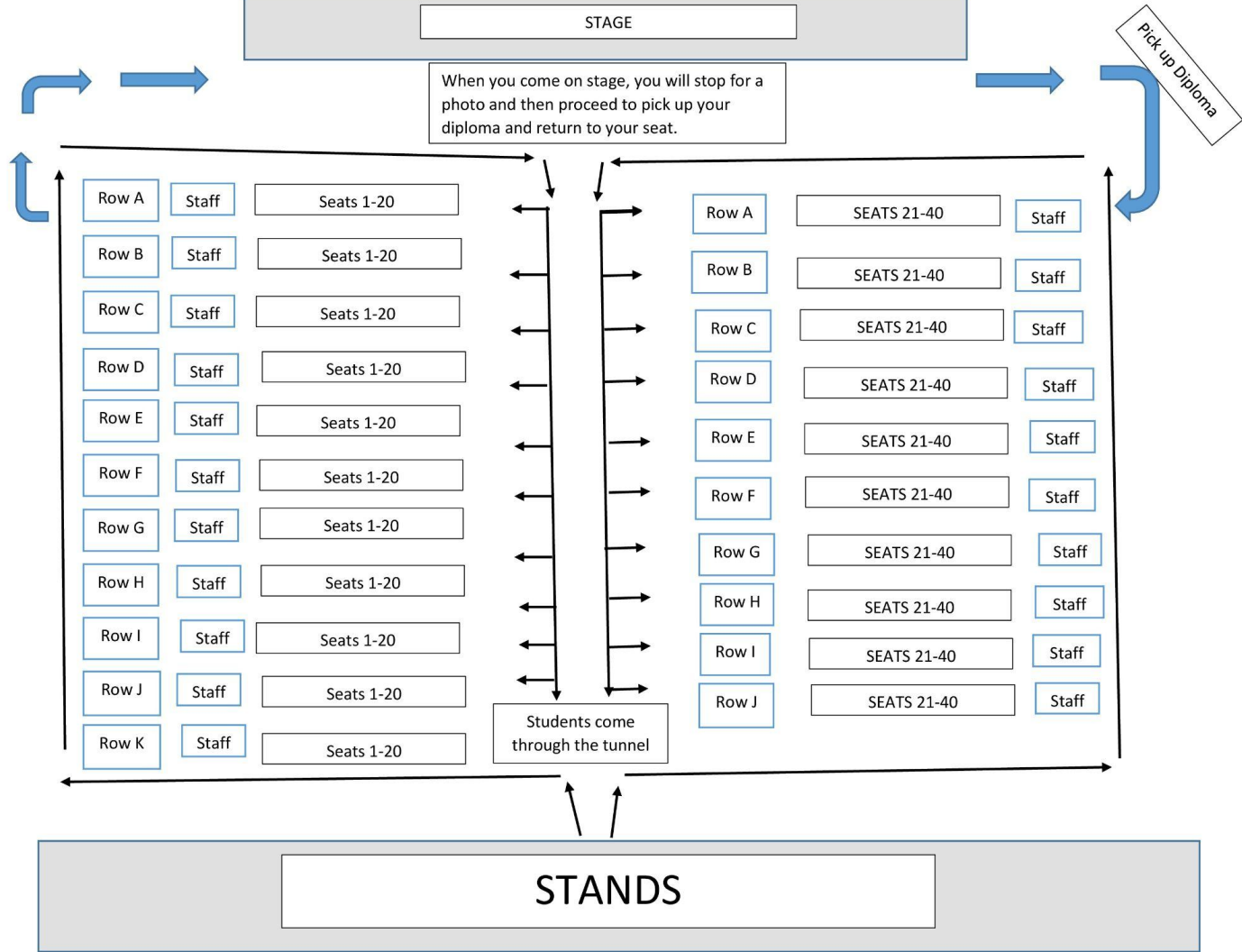




# Getting to the stage:
