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POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY – Automatic failure after two (2) absences whether excused or not. THREE (3) TARDIES EQUALS ONE (1) ABSENCE. (For Civics and Economics only one (1) absence is allowed.)

Policies

All policies are in accordance with Nashua High School discipline code and the Nashua School District. No smoking will be allowed at Nashua High School (within the building or on the grounds) in accordance with state law. Violations will result in suspension from class and a charged absence. Any behavior that impedes the operation of the Nashua Adult & Community School or negatively impacts a class will result in a student's removal from the course and/or the school.

Nashua High School North & South students:

All courses with the intent to have the credit transferred back to your high school must have permission from the guidance department prior to enrolling. Your guidance counselor must complete the form with course recommendation and year of graduation. Student is responsible for obtaining permission, or credit will not be awarded through the adult education program.

Payment and Refunds

Students can submit a check or money order made payable to the Nashua School District. Payment is required on the first day of class. There will be a \$25 processing fee charged for any returned checks. Refunds are granted in full if course is cancelled or requested before the second-class meeting.

Course Materials and School Property

All books, unless paid for by individual students, are the property of Nashua High School. Failure to return any Chromebooks or text books at the end of the course will result in a charge for the replacement costs of the text. Grades will be withheld until all materials are returned or until all charges are paid. Also, if any piece of equipment is broken and/or if the facility itself is damaged, the student will pay any repair/replacement costs. Again, grades will be withheld until all charges are paid.

School Calendar

The Nashua Adult & Community School follows the Nashua School District calendar during vacations and most holidays. All diploma and enrichment classes will still meet on early release days.
