Digital Photography

This course will take you through the basics of the "digital revolution". Whatever your photography interest, portraits, scenery, still life, or sports, it is all covered. This course is designed for the SLR type digital camera. ALWAYS bring your digital camera and manual to class each week.

Tour of Italy

Learning a new language can be challenging. Come explore Italy through its culture and language. Savor the language as we travel around Rome, Venice and Florence. Learn how to ask for a bottled water, where the train station is, and more of the basics of the Italian language. How to order a coffee. (There's a secret to it.) Lots of travel hints on getting around. Watch short film clips of ancient ruins. Explore Rome's street foods. Learn how to navigate the train station. What are the highlights of Northern Italy? How does Southern Italy compare? Find out the historical influences of the Spanish, Greeks and French.

Microsoft Excel Advanced Formulas

We will review mail merging, budgets, templates, charts, and any other techniques students would like to learn and understand.

American Sign Language (ASL)

Introduction to American Sign Language (ASL) emphasizes visual receptive and expressive use of the language, as well as provides an understanding of how facial expression and gestures work in the communication process. Participants will develop their skills through videotapes, classroom participation, and readings that also cover issues important to the Deaf community.

English Language Learners (ELL)

The English Language Learners (ELL) Program is an instructional program for students who are speakers of another language. The goal of this program is to develop English communication and cognitive-academic language skills.

German for Beginners

This is the introduction German class which will get you started with the German language from greetings to numbers and lets you begin your journey into the language. Students learn basic structures and vocabulary of elementary German. They practice speaking, listening, reading, and writing and learn to communicate in simple everyday situations. This class is intended for learners with no previous knowledge of German.

Advanced Spanish 1 and 2

The use of conversation in the Spanish language will be highly encouraged. However, the curriculum will be taught in a flexible manner so that the needs and interests of the attendees will be addressed and taught.

Crochet for Beginners

Learn several basic stitches, how to read a pattern, and make an item of your choice. True beginners, left handers and students who have a little bit of knowledge but want to expand their skills are welcome. You will need to bring some supplies for the class. Limit 10 students.

Glass Painting

Canvas is not the only medium for painting. Join us and learn techniques for painting on glass and how to cure the glass to make them dishwasher safe. Bring up to 6 of your favorite glass styles with stems or without. All other supplies will be provided.

Jewelry Design

This is a basic instruction course in the design and creation of individual jewelry pieces, starting with the most basic single strand necklace and progressing to more complicated designs as time permits. The material kit will include thread, wire, scissors, a wire cutter and chain nose pliers. Students will be asked to bring beads of their choice after the first class.

Ballroom Dancing

This is a sport for people of all ages and backgrounds. It does not require any special skills or dance ability. Ballroom dance is an activity you can enjoy at any age and a wonderful lifestyle in addition to keeping you healthy and fit. By learning simple dance steps, and their associated timing, you can find yourself quickly out on the dance floor having fun while moving to the music. Dance partners are not required. Please bring socks or slippers for the class.

Creative Aspects of Braiding Hair

This course will introduce the technical aspects of braiding and styling hair. Fathers will be able to bond with their daughters by braiding and style their hair before school and special events. Get experience practicing with the tools and products used in the hair industry by professional stylists. Hair braiding is a skill that can be taught at all levels. There will be many demonstrations and opportunities to work on mannequin heads to practice your skills.

Yoga

Enjoy this active, flowing style of yoga and pilates with special focus on abdominal control and dynamic flexibility of the body core. Your entire mind and body will benefit from this active practice with specific attention to breathing, stretching, strengthening and stress reduction in a safe and easy to learn environment. Please bring a yoga mat.

Pottery/Ceramics

Students will be introduced to the hand building techniques of pinch, coil and slab clay construction. Wheel throwing techniques as well as trimming and glaze application will be explored. A high fire stoneware clay body will be used.

Microsoft Office

Students will learn the basics of the standard Microsoft Office Suite; word, excel and PowerPoint with will cover creating and editing word documents. On the PowerPoint side, learn to put together slides along with animations and transitions, picture editing, etc. Within Excel, students will be introduced on how to use basic formulas and data. Additionally the teacher will review how to utilize online document applications in conjunction with Microsoft Office.

Small Engine Repair

This course is for beginners and intermediates interested in servicing their own small gas power equipment. Students may bring in their own equipment to work on or engines can be provided. This is a hands-on course which will start with basic internal combustion theory, then moves into break down and reassembly of an engine as well as problem diagnosis.

Woodworking

This course will include basic instruction in machine operation and safety. Mr. Mower will work with each student to create a class project. Limit 10 students.
