Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

The Nashua School District will run an online high school summer program for course recovery from Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> through Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>. The online program will consist of live (remote) daily class meetings from 9 AM until 11 AM.

Classes will not run if there is not sufficient enrollment. Students may also earn credits through Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO) through work skills, life experiences, and in classes such as Health and Physical Education.

Each morning students will meet online with teachers at 9 AM via Zoom or Google Meet. At the start of each class teachers will take attendance and review daily lesson objectives. The duration of online class time will vary but students need access to a computer or tablet for two hours. Attendance is mandatory every day. The summer session is short and daily attendance is vital for success, so as in the past, absences are limited to two. Attendance is particularly important this year due to the decrease in time of classes from 6 weeks to 3 weeks.

Teachers as well as the summer school guidance counselor will be available to consult with students during office hours before or after class each day. Veteran teachers have been polled and all courses will be covered by experienced summer school staff.

Course fees are as follows: Up to \$150.00 per class for Nashua Residents (many residents pay less than the full amount based on need) and \$200.00 per class for Non-Residents.

Students **must** consult with their guidance counselor prior to registering. Rolling registration will begin in May 15<sup>th</sup> and continue until July 2, 2020.
