
# Middle School Redistricting Enrollment and Team Projections

#### **Budget Forecast**

- Mayor Proposed Increase: 4%
  - FY24 Operating Budget: \$121,864,894
    - Increase: \$5,017,206 (Operating Budget x 4%)
- Human Capital Contractual Obligations: approx. \$3,500,000
- Federal Mandate: ELL Investment: 12-14 Positions approx. \$840,000-\$980,000
- Federal Mandate: Special Education: Absorb agency positions from ESSER min \$1,000,000

<sup>\*</sup>Projections are made with current enrollment figures from current 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students. Students without a variance, which represent 1,762 students, were assigned to a middle school per the recently approved boundaries. 112 students with a SPED variance were assumed to go to McCarthy. The remaining 150 students with a variance were evenly distributed to each school. More details are contained in later slides. Projections do not assume regularly seen attrition between fifth and sixth grades.





#### Sixth Grade Team Projections SY25










