Supported Decision Making



Supported decision making is an alternative to guardianship through which people use friends, family members and professionals to help them understand situations and choices they face, so they may make their own decisions without the “need” for guardianship.

If you’re already considering needing guardianship when your child turns 18, join us to learn more about supported decision making. It’s a new legal option and allows individuals to maintain a higher level of choice and independence than guardianship does.

Learn more about supported decision making and how to work with your IEP team during the high school years to prepare youth for greater independence and control over their own lives.
