Welcome Class of 2021!

The 2020-2021 academic year will soon begin and the yearbook staff is ready to begin working on the **Titan Yearbook**. We would like to inform the Class of 2021 of some important guidelines that everyone must follow in order to have their senior portrait included in the yearbook.

ALL senior yearbook portraits must be taken by Mark Lawrence Photographers in order to be included in The Titan yearbook. The deadline for having your yearbook portrait taken is November 1, 2020. (This date is subject to change). There will be no exceptions! This option will only be available by appointment and the single portrait taken is for Yearbook use only. Information will be available soon regarding time/date/scheduling of your appointment.

For students who choose to have senior portraits taken by a photographer other than Mark Lawrence Photography for distribution to family and friends, they will have 2 options for their yearbook photo:

1. Mark Lawrence Photographers will be at Nashua North for one day only to offer a "portrait sitting" for one yearbook photo only at NO CHARGE to NHSN seniors (with scheduled appointment). Date in October TBA.
2. If a student prefers to have their photo taken at the Mark Lawrence studio, there will be a sitting fee of \$30 (fee includes 6-8 indoor poses). They do have other options available for other fees (contact Mark Lawrence to schedule appointment)

The senior portraits are a head and shoulder photo only. We are looking for consistency in the book therefore these guidelines need to be followed.

By following these guidelines a senior can be certain that his or her photo will be among the Class of 2021 photos published in The Titan, (North's annual yearbook), without placing constraints on the senior and his or her family's selection of a senior portrait photographer.
