## **Agenda**

Introduction: Dr. Andrade introduced Preston Smith of Business Information Resources, the consultant NSD has hired to develop a redistricting plan. Mr. Smith gave an overview of his work, in particular talking about how not to initiate a redistricting plan with a committee. Toward that end, Mr. Smith wanted to be sure that the Committee understood that it is a working committee whose preliminary work remains in confidence until ready to seek community input later in the process. To accomplish the work, he explained committee members will be broken into sub-committees who will meet at least two or three times with him during February to develop several possible redistricting plans. The subcommittees provide equal voice and greater opportunity among committee members to share their thoughts on redrawing middle school boundaries.

Mr. Smith asked committee members to focus on developing a redistricting plan that balances enrollment between the three middle schools, using two criteria: free/reduced lunch percentages and travel distance. He also asked members to value the importance of being a member who is ...

- 1. Selfless because you are representing NSD as a whole
- 2. Cooperative
- 3. Committed to Confidentiality

<u>Establishment of Subcommittees</u>: Mr. Poska broke the committee into four subcommittees to work out a meeting schedule this month to meet via Zoom with Mr. Smith. The goal of the work this month is to bring back one, two, or several possible redistricting plans to share at the end of the month with the larger committee. The essence of the work is to troubleshoot all the possible nuances of new boundary lines for the middle schools.
