## HELP PREVENT YOUR CHILD FROM THE SUMMER SLIDE!

Many children, especially struggling readers, forget some of what they have learned over the summer months, this is what's known as the Summer Slide. But you can prevent your child from going down this slide by encouraging them to do the following:

Strategies to help your child maintain the reading skills they have learned.

- Read something every day – have your child choose a book, not too hard and not too easy, but just right and something of interest to them.
- Newspapers, magazines, TV schedules, recipes, and online resources provide functional reading.

- Read aloud to your child. All children benefit from being read to, even if they can read. It will build listening comprehension skills and increase knowledge and experience with text.
