Dear NSD Families and Staff,

Thank you for answering our phone call and registering your preference about April vacation.

We heard you. More than 6,000 preferred to eliminate April vacation and continue learning remotely that week, ending the school year a week earlier than scheduled. More than 1,700 preferred keeping vacation.

I reviewed results with the Nashua Board of Education. Last night the Board voted 9-0 to modify April vacation, establishing the following schedule:

Monday, April 27: Vacation Day

Tuesday, April 28 to Friday, May 1: Teaching and Learning at Home

Monday, June 15: Last Day of School

Once again, thank you for your time and attention to our phone poll; we appreciate your feedback.

Poll results highlight why communicating with purpose during school closure is particularly important. I want to ask again for your help in maintaining correct email addresses and phone numbers to help us reach you when needed.
