

## **EXPECTATIONS FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS (PK-5)**

The elementary remote school day will be from 8:15am-12Noon. Teachers will be off-line in the afternoon for outreach, planning, preparation, and/or to attend to other responsibilities.

Remote learning means that students are not receiving instruction in the same manner as if they were in their school buildings on a daily basis. Learning activities and communications are delivered electronically.

**Grades K-2:** Parents will receive a weekly communication from their child's teacher(s) with an explanation of that week's learning activities. Teachers will communicate with families/students and provide feedback on student progress. Teachers will be available for an "office hour" once a day which will be communicated through email/Google Classroom.

**Grades 3-5** Parents will receive a weekly communication from their child's teacher(s) with an explanation of that week's learning activities. Teachers will communicate with families/students and provide feedback on student progress. Learning activities will be occurring in Google Classroom, and students are expected to submit through Google Classroom. Teachers will be available for an "office hour" once a day which will be communicated through email/Google Classroom.

### **Notes for parents**

- All students should maintain some type of routine schedule. Have them wake up at a reasonable hour in the morning, attend to learning, allow some play time and scheduled time for lunch. Work with your child to stay on a schedule. If you are not receiving consistent communication from teachers, please reach out to your building administration.
- As outlined in the Elementary Student Handbook, parents should contact the school regarding student absences. If parents are unable to contact the school, parents should contact the teacher/building administrator. Patterns of absence not ascertained by the school to be caused by sickness or other justifiable reason, shall be reported by the Principal to the district's Attendance Officer/Court Liaison. Students who do not participate and/or engage in remote instruction will be given an unexcused absence.
