(If your child will be participating in ESY summer school, please keep the chrome book.) Staff will cross check the chrome book numbers and they will be deposited into a bin. Library books will also be collected at this time. Now is a good time to begin looking for those books.

Fifth Grade Celebration will take place on June 12th at 2pm. Teachers will line up around the building with signs. Students and families will drive through the bus loop and wave. More information will be provided closer to the date.
