- A. The mission of the Nashua Center for Life-Long Learning (NCLL) is to provide a wide variety of educational opportunities and experiences to our community and promote life-long learning.
 - a. Any student who is over 18 is eligible to enroll in the NCLL.
 - b. Current Nashua students interested in NCLL should meet with their School Counselors.
- B. The NCLL is a comprehensive standards-based program of studies intended to fulfill diverse educational needs of the community. It encompasses three programs:
 - 1. **High School Equivalency**: The NH Hi Set Testing Program and equivalency assessment.
 - 2. **High School Diploma Program**: A comprehensive program of credit courses in accordance with Ed. 702.1 shall be offered leading to a high school diploma upon successful completion of 20 units including the 11.5 units outlined in Table 1.
