- A. The mission of the Nashua Center for Life-Long Learning (NCLL) is to provide a wide variety of educational opportunities and experiences to our community and promote life-long learning.
- Any student who is over 18 is eligible to enroll in the NCLL.
 - Current Nashua students interested in NCLL should meet with their School Counselors.
- B. The NCLL is a comprehensive standards-based program of studies intended to fulfill diverse educational needs of the community. It encompasses three programs:
- High School Equivalency:** The NH Hi Set Testing Program and equivalency assessment.
 - High School Diploma Program:** A comprehensive program of credit courses in accordance with Ed. 702.1 shall be offered leading to a high school diploma upon successful completion of 20 units including the 11.5 units outlined in Table 1.

Table 1. Subject and Units of Credit for an Adult Ed High School Diploma

Science	2 units
Computer Literacy	½ unit
Electives	8½ units

*Sources of elective course credit shall be established in the Adult Ed High School Diploma course of studies in accordance with Ed. 702.06.
