ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

The school district of residence of a student is defined by RSA 193:12, II.

New Resident Students

All new resident students, accompanied by a parent/guardian, should register at school before opening day and as early as possible.

Children entering school for the first time must have proof of physical examination, immunization records, a copy of the child's birth certificate or other suitable documentation and proof of residency satisfactory to the Superintendent or his/her designee. Principals or their designees will meet with new children and parents to explain school programs.
