# STUDENT/PARENT/GUARDIAN CHROMEBOOK AGREEMENT

The Nashua School District believes that providing Chromebooks to our students enhances their educational experience and provides increased opportunities for learning. As such, we provide our students Chromebooks for their educational use for the school year. All students will be issued a district-owned device. There will be times when students will be required to utilize this device in the class at the discretion of the teacher.

# **Losses That Are Not Covered**

<u>Intentional Acts:</u> The agreement will not cover loss or damage caused by your intentional damage or destruction of property covered under this agreement. Students will be responsible for the full cost of the Chromebook if it is determined there has been intentional damage and may result in discipline consistent with damaging of school property, including but not limited to the student losing their privilege of using school technology. Discipline is at the discretion of building administration.

<u>Corrosion and Rust:</u> The agreement will not cover loss or damage caused by or resulting from corrosion, rust or changes in humidity or temperature.

<u>Dishonest Acts:</u> The agreement will not cover loss or damage caused by dishonesty or anyone acting on your behalf. This includes intentional actions or acts of negligence pertaining to the Chromebook. There is no coverage from any loss or damage arising from illegal acts, whether committed alone or in collusion with others. However, if the loss or damage is caused by an act arising out of a pattern of criminal domestic violence and the perpetrator of the loss is criminally prosecuted for the act causing the loss. <u>Electronic Breakdown:</u> The agreement will not cover loss or damage to electrical equipment caused by electricity other than lightning, including damage arising from using charging materials that are not Chromebook certified.

<u>Theft from an Unattended Vehicle:</u> The agreement will not cover loss or damage that is caused by or resulting from theft from an unattended vehicle except when it is securely locked, its windows are fully closed, and there is visible evidence that entry into the vehicle was forced.

<u>Theft Without a Police Report:</u> The agreement will not cover loss or damage that is caused by or resulting from a theft without a police report being provided. There is a limit of coverage for one theft per agreement period.

# What to Do if You Have a Loss

If you have a loss to property covered by the agreement, you must:

- 1. notify the Nashua Police immediately upon discovery of the loss if the loss is a theft;
- 2. report the loss to school administration immediately. Complete the Loss Report Form.

# What to Do if You Have Damage

If you have accidental damage to property covered by this agreement, you must:

- 1. notify the school administrators immediately complete with how the damage occurred;
- 2. do everything possible to protect the property from further damage.
- 3. if loss has occurred without policy report and after investigation by both police and the district concludes the student is responsible for the loss, the student will be responsible for the cost of the device. The cost of the device will be determined by the building administrators and the Department of Information Technology. If there is a failure to pay, there will be a hold place on the student's account.
- 4. if there is a total loss or damage to where the Chromebook is lost or damaged beyond repair and deemed unintentional, there will be another fee imposed on the student to receive another Chromebook. There will be a maximum of two Chromebooks lent out to a student per academic year.

# **General Rules and Conditions**

You may not cancel this agreement. If you choose to accept the device, you agree to pay the Technology Fee and accept the terms for the duration of the academic year. There are no refunds provided for students who withdraw from the Nashua School District prior to the end of the school year.

The Nashua School District (NSD) has initiated a program to loan each student who is actively enrolled in grades 6-12 a Chromebook device and related peripherals. Participation in this program is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- The student must be actively enrolled at one of the following schools: Fairgrounds, Elm Street, or Pennichuck (middle schools), Nashua North or Nashua South (high schools).
- The Chromebook and related peripherals are on loan and remain the property of the Nashua School District.
- Both student and parent/guardian agree to adhere to the terms and conditions of the *Chromebook Care and Use Policy Guide*.
- The student shall be the exclusive user of this device and shall not grant access to any other individual.
- The student must comply with all applicable software license agreements.
- Chromebooks and peripherals must be returned in good condition with reasonable wear and tear as outlined in the *Chromebook Care and Use Policy Guide*.
- NSD may take disciplinary measures if the Chromebook and peripherals are not returned on or before the return date.
- The care of the Chromebook and related peripherals are the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian while in their care.
- There may be a fee assessed if the Chromebook and/or peripherals are broken, lost, or damaged. Consideration of fees will be made for students with a documented financial need.
- Chromebooks that are broken or fail to work properly must be reported as soon as possible so that they can be taken care of properly.
- District-owned Chromebooks should never be taken to an outside computer service for any type of repair or maintenance.
