- Any Class I or Class II violation as outlined in POPPS Policy JJJ Student Behavior Standards found in the Student Handbook may result in suspension for the semester or removal from office for the rest of the school year.

CLASS OFFICER EXPECTATIONS:

- a. Attend required meetings (i.e. officer, council and principal's leadership team)
- b. Assist in organizing planned events as well as attend all class events unless excused with permission
- c. Participate in other class events when able
- d. Demonstrate school wide leadership skills by words, actions and example.
- Officers must have no more than 4 unexcused tardies and/or 2 unexcused absences per term
