MANAGING ASBESTOS IN SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires school districts to inspect, monitor and, when necessary, remove asbestos from school buildings. The School District contracted with a licensed firm to inspect each building for asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) and to prepare an Asbestos Management Plan that identifies the location and condition of all ACBM. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency requires that AHERA re-inspections be conducted by licensed inspectors every three (3) years to note any changes in the ACBM. The District will conform to AHERA and reinspect every three (3) years. Copies of the Asbestos Management Plan and reinspection reports for the School District are on file at the Plant Operations Office and at each school office.
