EXCLUSION OF STUDENTS FROM SCHOOL FOR ILLNESS

A student may be excluded from school when they exhibit symptoms of a contagious or communicable illness, or is otherwise a hazard to themselves or others. Determinations to exclude a child based upon a contagious or communicable illness, or other medical conditions shall be made pursuant to Board Policy JLCG-R. Exclusions based upon hazards other than contagious or communicable disease may only occur with the approval of the Superintendent. Parents/Guardians will be notified if their child is excluded from school and provided with criteria for readmission. The school nurse, under the direction of the Superintendent, will have the sole discretion to allow the re-admittance of a student.

If a student is disabled under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA), the New Hampshire RSA 186-C, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Americans with Disabilities Act, or any other law providing special rights to any child with a disability as defined in Ed 1102.01(t), those laws shall govern and shall supersede this policy to the extent this policy may be inconsistent with those laws.
