

BOARD RECORDS

1. The Board shall maintain accurate records of their meetings, setting forth the action taken at each meeting, including executive sessions. A summary of all matters voted shall be made available to the public seventy-two hours after each meeting; provided, however, that votes taken in nonpublic session, for matters covered under exemption authorized in RSA 91-A:5, may remain undisclosed to the public so long as their publication would defeat the purposes of the nonpublic session, but no longer.
2. All such records shall be maintained in the office of the Superintendent of Schools and be available for public inspection in accordance with the Right to Know Law.
