

FREE EXERCISE OF RELIGION

Pursuant to R.S.A. 189:1-b:

1. On each school day, before classes of instruction officially convene in each school, a period of not more than 5 minutes shall be available upon request to those who may wish to exercise their right to freedom of assembly and participate voluntarily in the free exercise of religion at a place designated by the school principal.
2. There shall be no teacher supervision of this free exercise of religion but supervision to insure the safety of students and the orderly conduct of the school shall be allowed at the discretion of the school principal.
3. There shall be no prescribed or proscribed form or content of prayer.
4. No person shall be allowed on school premises for the purpose of organizing, supervising, or conducting this period of free exercise of religion.
