

**STUDENT/PARENT/GUARDIAN CHROMEBOOK AGREEMENT**

The Nashua School District believes that providing Chromebooks to our students enhances their educational experience and provides increased opportunities for learning. As such, we provide our students Chromebooks for their educational use for the school year.

**Principles and Declaration**

A Technology Fee is required for all students who are borrowing a school-issued Chromebook and will cover your school-issued Chromebook against a variety of losses and accidental damage. The cost of this fee is \$25 per year, renewed annually. The District reserves the right to amend the agreement at any time.

**Technology Fee Coverage**

This agreement will cover direct physical loss caused by accidental damage (caused by normal and intended use of equipment, such as a broken or cracked screen), fire, flood, vandalism, natural disasters, and power surge due to lightning occurring during the agreement period to the Chromebook, including items entrusted to you, worldwide, as long as the items were in your possession and reported to the District. It will also cover malfunction of the device that arises naturally and through no fault of the user.

**Losses That Are Not Covered**

**Intentional Acts:** The agreement will not cover loss or damage caused by your intentional damage or destruction of property covered under this agreement. Students will be responsible for the full cost of the Chromebook if it is determined there has been intentional damage and may result in discipline consistent with damaging of school property, including but not limited to the student losing their privilege of using school technology. Discipline is at the discretion of building administration.

**Corrosion and Rust:** The agreement will not cover loss or damage caused by or resulting from corrosion, rust or changes in humidity or temperature.

**Dishonest Acts:** The agreement will not cover loss or damage caused by dishonesty or anyone acting on your behalf. There is no coverage from any loss or damage arising from illegal acts, whether committed alone or in collusion with others. However, if the loss or damage is caused by an act arising out of a pattern of criminal domestic violence and the perpetrator of the loss is criminally prosecuted for the act causing the loss.

**Electronic Breakdown:** The agreement will not cover loss or damage to electrical equipment caused by electricity other than lightning, including damage arising from using charging materials that are not Chromebook certified.

**Theft from an Unattended Vehicle:** The agreement will not cover loss or damage that is caused by or resulting from theft from an unattended vehicle except when it is securely locked, its windows are fully closed, and there is visible evidence that entry into the vehicle was forced.

**Theft Without a Police Report:** The agreement will not cover loss or damage that is caused by or resulting from a theft without a police report being provided. There is a limit of coverage for one theft per agreement period.

**What to Do if You Have a Loss**

If you have a loss to property covered by the agreement, you must:

- (1) notify the Nashua Police immediately upon discovery of the loss if the loss is a theft;
- (2) report the loss to school administration immediately. Complete the Loss Report Form.

**What to Do if You Have Damage**

If you have accidental damage to property covered by this agreement, you must:

- (1) notify the school administrators immediately complete with how the damage occurred;
- (2) do everything possible to protect the property from further damage.

**General Rules and Conditions**

You may not cancel this agreement. If you choose to accept the device, you agree to pay the Technology Fee and accept the terms for the duration of the academic year. There are no refunds provided for students who withdraw from the Nashua School District prior to the end of the school year.

The fee will cover your device for the duration of the school year. Regardless of the time of year, if a student is issued a District Chromebook, the fee will remain at \$25.

By signing below, the student and parent/guardian have read and acknowledge all conditions of this agreement, including:

- I/We understand that the Chromebook and its accessory equipment are the property of the Nashua School District.
- I/We understand that the student, with the support of the parent/guardian, if a Chromebooks is brought home, both are responsible for the care and maintenance of the Chromebook.
- I/We understand that the Chromebook will be returned at the end of the school year or at the discretion of the Nashua School District.
- I/We understand that I/we must report all Chromebook damages or the theft/loss of the device to Building Administration immediately with a police report filed for any theft.
- I/We understand that if a Chromebook is brought home, the device must be returned fully charged upon return to school.
- I/We understand that the Chromebook must be returned to the District upon unenrollment from the Nashua School District. Failure to return the device will result in a report to the Nashua Police Department and the student will be billed for full purchase price of the device.
